

**BYLAW 22-022
OF
LAC LA BICHE COUNTY**

A BYLAW OF LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE LAC LA BICHE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE BYLAW.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M 26, and amendments thereto, Council may pass a bylaw in relation to the establishment and function of Council Committees, and the procedures and conduct of Council Committees;

AND WHEREAS Lac La Biche County Council adopted Bylaw 20-039 as the Lac La Biche County Economic Development Advisory Committee Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend Bylaw 20-039;

NOW THEREFORE under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the said *Municipal Government Act*, and by virtue of all other enabling powers, the Council of Lac La Biche County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1(1) The Economic Development Advisory Committee Bylaw 20-039 is amended as set out in this Bylaw.

(2) Section 2 shall be amended to the following:

“The Committee shall consist of up to ten (10) voting members, appointed by resolution of Council, in accordance with the following structure:

- a. two (2) members of Council; and
- b. up to eight (8) designated seats for other persons.”

(3) In the event of conflict between the Bylaw and Terms of Reference, the Bylaw shall prevail.

Severability

2 Each provision of this Bylaw is independent of all other provisions. If any such provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions of this Bylaw will remain valid and enforceable.

Effective Date

3 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third reading.
